## EASTERN MILLS COUNTY

### Fisher Wildlife Area

Lambert Ave                      Malvern, IA  
2.5 miles east of Malvern on Lambert Ave (old H38)  
On north side of road, west side of West Nishnabotna River



This 20-acre area is a recent addition to the Mills County Conservation Board's publicly accessible areas with assistance from the local chapter of Pheasants Forever. The area consists of previously established Quail and Riparian Buffer strips as well as general green space and river bottom timber. The Fisher Wildlife Area provides habitat for wildlife, access to the West Nishnabotna River for recreationists, and is open to public hunting.

### RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR FISHER WILDLIFE AREA

DO NOT LITTER – CARRY OUT WHAT YOU CARRY IN.  
NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES BEYOND PARKING AREA.  
NO FIREWORKS.  
NO SWIMMING.  
NO CAMPING.  
NO OPEN FIRES.

NO ANIMAL SHALL BE HITCHED OR TIED TO ANY TREE OR SHRUB, OR IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO RESULT IN INJURY TO PROPERTY.

It is illegal to remove, injure, destroy or deface any natural or man-made structures or materials, including trees, flowers or wildlife (except during scheduled Iowa DNR hunting seasons) except with the written permission of the Mills County Conservation Board. (Mushrooms, fruits and nuts can be harvested for personal use.) This section shall not apply to the MCCB or its officers.
