

# EXPLORE YOUR MILLS COUNTY PARKS!

## WESTERN MILLS COUNTY

### Mile Hill Lake & Scenic Overlook

21193 US Hwy 34    Glenwood, IA  
2 miles west of Glenwood on Hwy 34  
(Access is on eastbound Hwy 34)



This 39-acre park consists of a hardwood forest, which is open to public hunting, and a 10-acre fishing lake with boat dock and ramp. The lake is considered a No Wake Zone and is closed to swimming. When driving into the park you will find an interpretive panel discussing the pre-historic culture that lived in this region, and the handicap accessible Scenic Overlook, which offers an interpretive panel discussing the Loess Hills Scenic Byway. You will also see a 2 acre restored prairie, and several flowerbeds which are maintained by the Mills County Co-Horts. There are various hiking trails within the park, including the most recent addition that leads through a marsh area, with a newly installed footbridge.

### RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR MILE HILL LAKE

DO NOT LITTER – CARRY OUT WHAT YOU CARRY IN.  
NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES BEYOND PARKING AREAS.  
VEHICLES NOT ALLOWED OFF ROADWAY.  
HUNTING PERMITTED  
TRAPPING ALLOWED BY PERMIT ONLY. PERMIT CAN BE REQUESTED FROM DIRECTOR.  
NO FIREWORKS.  
NO SWIMMING.  
NO CAMPING.  
NO OPEN FIRES.

# **EXPLORE YOUR MILLS COUNTY PARKS!**

PETS MUST REMAIN ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES.

NO ANIMAL SHALL BE HITCHED OR TIED TO ANY TREE OR SHRUB, OR IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO RESULT IN INJURY TO PROPERTY.

It is illegal to remove, injure, destroy or deface any natural or man-made structures or materials, including trees, flowers or wildlife (except during scheduled Iowa DNR hunting seasons) except with the written permission of the Mills County Conservation Board. (Mushrooms, fruits and nuts can be harvested for personal use.) This section shall not apply to the MCCB or its officers.
