Pony Creek Access

Deacon Road Pacific Junction, IA
½ mile North of Pony Creek Park on Deacon Road



This area is well groomed and has a gravel-parking lot which handles overflow crowds from Pony Creek Park. It also provides access to an 82-acre lake for shore fishermen and canoe enthusiasts. There is one picnic shelter located here with 2 group grills. The shelter can be reserved for a non-refundable fee of \$25.00 per day. The area also has picnic tables at 5 different pedestal grill sites for picnickers.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR PONY CREEK ACCESS

DO NOT LITTER – CARRY OUT WHAT YOU CARRY IN.
NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES BEYOND PARKING AREAS.
NO HUNTING OR TRAPPING.
NO FIREARMS.
NO FIREWORKS.
NO SWIMMING.
NO CAMPING.
NO OPEN FIRES.
PETS MUST REMAIN ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES.

NO ANIMAL SHALL BE HITCHED OR TIED TO ANY TREE OR SHRUB, OR IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO RESULT IN INJURY TO PROPERTY.

It is illegal to remove, injure, destroy or deface any natural or man-made structures or materials, including trees, flowers or wildlife except with the written permission of the Mills County Conservation Board. (Mushrooms, fruits and nuts can be harvested for personal use.) This section shall not apply to the MCCB or its officers.
