Wabash Trace Nature Trail

Access points in Mineola, Silver City and Malvern.



The Wabash Trace Nature Trail is a former railroad corridor that has been converted to a multi-purpose trail with a limestone surface. The trail is 63 miles long, with 25 miles of the trail being in Mills County. This creates approximately 300 acres of linear park within Mills County that is open year round to bicycling, walking / running, cross country skiing and nature viewing. Motorized vehicles, including ATV's, are not permitted on the Trace.

Southwest Iowa Nature Trails (SWINT) continues to maintain the Wabash Trace and promotes the Trace on a daily basis. A user pass is required and all funds from sales of user passes go to maintaining the Wabash Trace. The daily pass can be found in yellow posts at the access points to the trail which are found ½ mile north of Main Street Mineola on H12, on the west side of Main Street in Silver City, and near Bohner Pond (3rd & 5th) in Malvern. Passes may also be obtained from businesses along the trace.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE WABASH TRACE NATURE TRAIL

DO NOT LITTER – CARRY OUT WHAT YOU CARRY IN.

NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES ON TRACE.

NO HUNTING OR TRAPPING.

NO FIREARMS.

NO FIREWORKS.

NO CAMPING.

NO OPEN FIRES.

PETS MUST REMAIN ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES.

NO ANIMAL SHALL BE HITCHED OR TIED TO ANY TREE OR SHRUB, OR IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO RESULT IN INJURY TO PROPERTY.

It is illegal to remove, injure, destroy or deface any natural or man-made structures or materials, including trees, flowers or wildlife except with the written permission of the Mills County Conservation Board. (Mushrooms, fruits and nuts can be harvested for personal use.) This section shall not apply to the MCCB or its officers.
